

ROCKS

Each rock has many sides to play with when building alone for relaxation. But, during game play with others, only specific sides of each rock may be used for stacking. These sides are the top and bottom when the rock is standing at full height AND the largest, non-angled, flat sides when the rock is placed on its side like an egg.

GAMEPLAY

On a stable level play surface, take turns rolling the die and stacking one rock (ANY SIZE) of the color rolled. If no rocks remain of the color rolled, player does not stack a rock and the turn ends. Rolling SKIP means player does not stack a rock and rolling WILD means player must stack one rock of any color from the remaining rocks. A player's turn ends when the next player rolls the die. When a player knocks over the stack, they lose that round. A player wins by successfully stacking the last stone!

QUESTION CARDS

Make TOTIKA KOHATU a party game or a question & answer teaching or training game by using blank cards to write challenges or questions. On each turn, only after successfully stacking a rock, player draws a card and makes another player perform the challenge or asks another player the same color question as their stacked rock.
